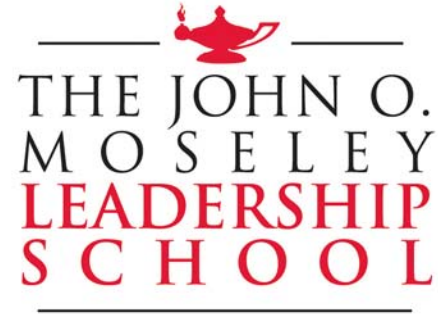


## **77<sup>th</sup> John O. Moseley Leadership School Ambassador Application**



For 76 years, aspiring members of Sigma Alpha Epsilon have developed personally and fraternally at Leadership School. A small group of individuals have participated in what has become known as the “National Chapter” of Sigma Alpha Epsilon through a program that, in its most recent incarnation, is known as the Ambassador Program. Dedicated and thoughtful students assist the staff and faculty to make Leadership School a success, participate in a personal-development curriculum, make connections with other students and serve as role models for students while they are at Leadership School and for when they return home.

This year’s Leadership School will be held on Royal Caribbean Cruise Line’s “Majesty of the Sea.” The cruise will depart from and return to Miami, Florida, from August 6-10, 2012. Ambassadors are expected to arrive one day early for training.

### **Application Instructions**

Fields with red outlines are required, and the application is best completed on a PC using Adobe Acrobat Reader 9<sup>®</sup> or higher. If you do not have that version, you can go online to [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com) and download it for free. If you are using a Mac, do not use the Preview program to complete the form, as the form will not work properly.

At any point during the process, Acrobat<sup>®</sup> will allow you to save the application and come back to it at another time. When you are finished, click on the “Submit” button at the very end of the document and follow the prompts. Your file will be saved on your local system or attached to an e-mail if you use Microsoft Outlook<sup>®</sup>. If the file saves to your system, simply attach the document to an e-mail to Director of Educational Programs James Irwin at [jirwin@sae.net](mailto:jirwin@sae.net). Don’t forget to also attach your resumé and a clear, good photo of yourself, which are required.

**The application deadline for all materials is March 15, 2012.**

### **Application Requirements**

To be considered for the Ambassador position, the applicant must be a graduate of the John O. Moseley Leadership School and have at least one semester of school left following the Leadership School, preferably in the fall of 2012.

### **Logistical Information for Ambassadors**

Please be available to arrive by 12:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 5, 2011, and depart at approximately 2:00 p.m. on Friday, August 10. You are responsible for your own transportation to and from Miami, Florida. Sigma Alpha Epsilon will cover your tuition,

pre-cruise hotel lodging (on the night of August 5 only), for training, cruise berth and related fees.

*Please note that a passport is required to travel on the cruise ship.*

There will be several conference calls in the months leading up to the school that you will need to join. They will be on a weekday evening and last no more than 90 minutes. Additionally, some training materials may be sent prior to the school that we will ask you to review. As an Ambassador, you will be asked to help promote the school through phone calls made to Eminent Archons throughout the Realm. Calls will be divided up equally among the Ambassadors.
