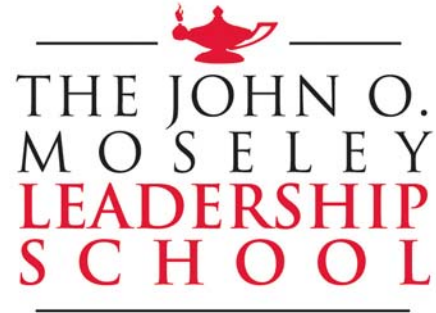


77th John O. Moseley Leadership School Faculty Application

For 76 years, aspiring members of Sigma Alpha Epsilon have developed personally and fraternally at Leadership School. Dedicated and thoughtful alumni make connections with these leaders and are necessary to serve in simultaneous roles as mentors, teachers and facilitators.



Members of the Leadership School faculty serve by leading a group of approximately 10 brothers through a guided chapter curriculum in chapter meetings that take place at various times throughout Leadership School. Faculty members share personal stories, present leadership knowledge and challenge the group to reflect, learn and develop. Some faculty members either led or assisted a breakout session or seminar discussion sharing personal expertise in areas such as financial management, the Ritual or other similar area.

Throughout Leadership School, faculty members work and mentor Leadership School delegates, model appropriate behavior and help to ensure each delegate has a meaningful Leadership School experience. There is time for the faculty to connect with each other, too, because the faculty needs to work together to ensure a positive experience for the delegates. Training activities for the faculty are designed to develop confidence in the material and process as well as to foster fun and teamwork.

Leadership School is an opportunity to serve aspiring young leaders and connect with other like-minded alumni.

This year's Leadership School will be held on Royal Caribbean Cruise Line's Ship "Majesty of the Seas." The cruise will depart from and return to Miami, Florida, from August 6-10, 2012. Faculty members are expected to arrive a day early for training.

Application Instructions

Fields with red outlines are required, and the application is best completed on a PC using Adobe Acrobat Reader 9[®] or higher. If you do not have that version, you can go online to www.adobe.com and download it for free. If you are using a Mac, do not use the Preview program to complete the form, as the form will not work properly.

At any point during the process, Acrobat® will allow you to save the application and come back to it at another time. When you are finished, click on the “Submit” button at the very end of the document and follow the prompts. Your file will be saved on your local system or attached to an e-mail if you use Microsoft Outlook®. If the file saves to your system, simply attach the document to an e-mail to Director of Educational Programs James Irwin at jirwin@sae.net. Don’t forget to also attach your resumé and a clear, good photo of yourself, which are required.

Logistical Information

Please be available to arrive and be ready to go by 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 5, 2012, and depart at approximately 2:00 p.m. on Friday, August 10. This year, as part of your service on the faculty, full reimbursement for travel expenses will be provided.

Please note that a passport is required to travel on the cruise ship.

There will be at least one conference call in the months leading up to the school that you will need to join. It will be on a weekday evening and last no more than 90 minutes. Additionally, some training materials may be sent prior to the school that we will ask you to review and familiarize yourself with.
