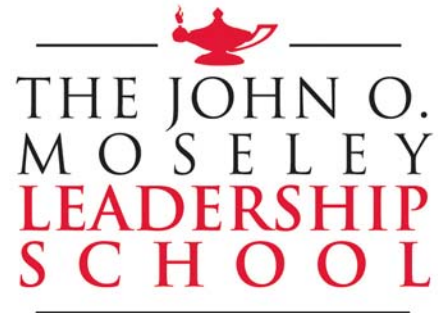


**Merit Key Society and
Charles F. Collins Fund
Leadership School Scholarship Application**



By completing this application, you will be considered to receive one of the 27 Leadership School national scholarships that are available.

The Scholarship Endowment Fund of Sigma Alpha Epsilon's Merit Key Society will be used to award seven scholarships of \$550 each, given to six brothers to pay for Leadership School tuition for the 77th John O. Moseley Leadership School. The Charles F. Collins Fund of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon Foundation will be used to award 20 scholarships of \$275 each, given to 20 brothers as part of the tuition for the 77th John O. Moseley Leadership School.

Application Instructions

Fields with red outlines are required, and the application is best completed on a PC using Adobe Acrobat Reader 9[®]. If you do not have that version, you can go online to www.adobe.com and download it for free. If you are using a Mac, do not use the Preview program to complete the form, as the form will not work properly.

At any point during the process, Acrobat[®] will allow you to save the application and come back to it at another time. When you are finished, click on the "Submit" button at the very end of the document and follow the prompts. Your file will be saved on your local system or attached to an e-mail if you use Microsoft Outlook[®]. If the file saves to your system, simply attach the document to an e-mail to Director of Educational Programs James Irwin at jirwin@sae.net.

This application and the transcript must be received by Director of Educational Programs James Irwin no later than May 1, 2012. The application and transcript can be sent to either James Irwin, 1856 Sheridan Road, Evanston, IL 60201-3837, or to jirwin@sae.net.

You will be notified by May 15, 2012, about the status of your application.

Application Requirements

- Each application must be completed in full, as incomplete applications will be automatically rejected. Brothers who do not know their badge numbers should contact the Fraternity Service Center.
- Each applicant an initiated active undergraduate brother with sophomore-credit standing or more.

- Each applicant must have at least a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better to be eligible.
- Each applicant's chapter must be in good financial and report standing with the Fraternity Service Center as determined by the Department of Member Services.
- Each applicant must submit a transcript with his application. While an official, sealed transcript is preferred, the applicant may submit an electronic or other unofficial transcript.
- Letters of recommendation are not required and should not be submitted.

Late or incomplete applications will be rejected. Winners of the scholarship will have their scholarship monies applied to their Leadership School tuition.
